

On 23 November 2017 Supreme extended the deadline for wearing the old regalia in Honour Guards until the **30 June 2019**. As of now there is no change to this deadline. Supreme has released the new Fourth Degree tie for sale at a price of \$50, with the exchange rate the price will be over \$65, plus shipping. I didn't notice any other individual parts of the new uniform for sale. The price for the new complete official dress uniform remains at \$510 US, and with the current exchange rate the cost will be \$672 Cdn, plus shipping. "Roger Sauve" in Montreal, Supreme's Canadian outlet still lists only the old Fourth Degree regalia.
