There hasn't been any additional information from Supreme since last November regarding the new 4th Degree uniform when they extended the deadline for wearing of the old regalia to June 30th 2019. As of the end of February Roger Sauve and two other American outlets are only advertising old regalia items. It seems that Supreme will be the only outlet for the new uniforms for the foreseeable future. At present they are selling complete uniforms only. They will not be selling individual items such as ties or berets. The price for the new uniform is now \$510 US dollars plus shipping. There has been 8000 new uniforms ordered since they were introduced in August of last year. I am sure that there will be future changes before we have switched over completely to the new uniform.

FROM THE GUARD COMMANDER

SITTING WHILE ARMED WITH THE SWORD

1. Knights of Columbus should remain standing throughout their attendance in a drill however, to prevent distractions to others behind the formation and to provide that others be able to see, it will occasionally be necessary for Knights of Columbus to be seated. This is particularly true in Church. To provide uniformity and to maintain control of the sword in the scabbard while seated, the following procedure will be utilized.

2. As you begin to be seated, grasp the upper band of the scabbard with the left hand and carry the sword and the scabbard forward and across the lap. When seated, the sword will then rest in the scabbard with the body of the scabbard at an angle across the lap with the foot of the scabbard pointed towards the right front. (See Figure 26.)

3. The Sir Knight must keep control over the scabbard to prevent the scabbard from striking the seats or pews to not be distracting.
