DAILY MASS

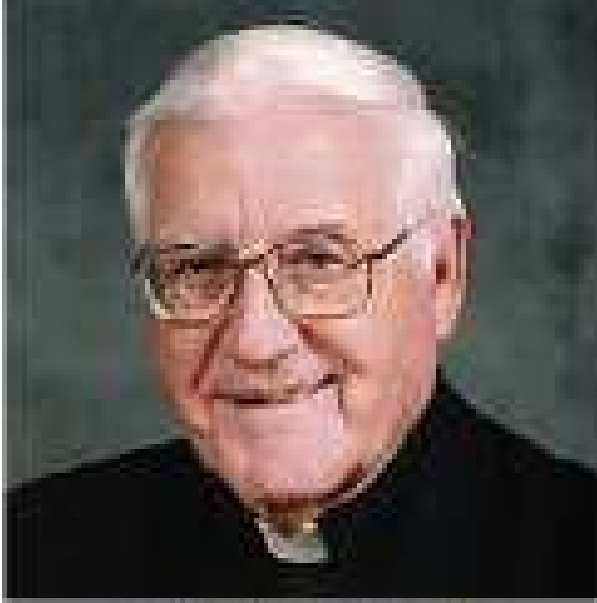
