GREETINGS MY BROTHER KNIGHTS:

It's hard to believe but almost a year has gone by since I became your Grand Knight. Overall I would have to say it's been a very successful 10 months. We've experienced both sides of the spectrum. Having said that, the positives far outweighed the negatives. A great deal of thanks needs to go out to all the volunteers for your extreme effort and time put in over these months! As the Grand Knight, I am deeply grateful. It wouldn't be appropriate of me and it would be very difficult to particularly name specific Knights as there have been many that stepped up each and every time to cover

all the bases. You all have my deepest gratitude. To point out one or two very successful Council's endeavours would be appropriate. Our Basketball Free Throw Competitions immediately comes to mind. This year over 900 students participated within our district! Last year we had just over 600 students. This is a huge increase and again it could not have happened without the almost 20 knights who volunteered of their time to make this happen. In addition we saw a huge increase in parent and grandparent participation. The bleachers were full at each of the venues in each of the schools! It's also gratifying to all the 'pancake breakfast' volunteers to see the number of breakfasts we've served especially the last 2 breakfasts. It's important to mention that the all proceeds from these pancake breakfasts were dedicated to the church building and maintenance funds. This year our Council will hold a total of 6 pancake breakfasts with the proceeds going toward our church building and maintenance (most of which will be for the new roof). Again as in the past our Council and it's various charities that we sponsor will have donated approximately \$40,000.00 toward these groups and organizations. Yes, this Council does make a difference! It's to this end that a worry has crept in. In spite of the very good works that our Council carries out year in and year out, our membership is declining and the same approximately 20 or so volunteers who are counted on for each and every function are quite simply, becoming tired. We need our younger Knights to step up! We need our younger Knights to attend our meetings and start to fill in the gaps! There has been a meeting or two in the past little while where we have been hard pressed to form a quorum. We

need a stronger commitment also from the 'rank and file' to attend these meetings. It's when you attend and learn about our goals and the different projects being looked at that you get an appreciation for the whole of the Order. There is no soft, quiet or fuzzy way to say this...if we don't have your participation, sooner or later the Council will fail. Attendance is important! Attendance means getting and being involved. It also means friendship and brotherhood and a duty as a Knight to serve. This Council was formed approximately 36 years ago and over that period has proven it's worth time and again to our Parish our Church and our Community. It's a legacy that shouldn't be taken lightly.
